- 1. Meeting called to order at 4:00 pm. by Mendonca.
- 2. Introductions were made. We had a special guest student from Costa Rica.
- 3. The Secretary's minutes of the February meeting were read. Motion to approve by Wilson and second by Jabaay was made. Motion approved.
- 4. Wang gave a Treasurer's Report of \$3564.24 with \$2150 in the scholarship fund.
- 5. Toni noted that the State section of the National IFT website is not up to date. She will contact National to update.
- 6. ISU Food Science Club update as follows:

They will have fudge at VEISHA and it can still be ordered online. Kate Gilbert got the Leadership Award and will ride in the VEISHA parade. They enjoyed their Club trip to Wisconsin with 23 students visiting Swiss Colony, Oscar-Mayer and 2 other cheese factories and a Micro-brewery.

- 7. MFPC will be 11-6-07 with Chicago hosting and again including the Challenge. Wilson reported the name of the Conference will be changing. More to follow! Wilson also reported on advertising going out for a meeting at ISU in the Wellness Center on Starches May 8-9, 2007.
- 8. Gits reported on the Governance Meeting she attended in Chicago on 3-23. It is basically eliminating the Councilors and establishing Town Meetings.
- 9.
